

## COMMUNITY GARDEN PLOT GUIDLINES

- ✿ Please park in Mary Lyon parking lot across Harvard Avenue from the garden area, **not on the lawn.**
- ✿ Gardeners must supply all their own tools, seeds, fertilizer, and water.
- ✿ Individual gardeners are responsible for the maintenance of their plots (keeping them weed free). Those plots that are not maintained will be mowed over after notification. Plots will be inspected every two weeks. **All trash and debris must be taken away from the site by participants.** An area for compost materials will be designated. **Also, do not put stones and rocks in the lawn surrounding the gardens.** The lawn must be clear of debris for the mowers to do their job.
- ✿ If, due to unexpected circumstances, gardeners find that they are unable to maintain their plot, they are requested to notify this office as early as possible.
- ✿ Please do not plant perennials, bulbs, mint, Jerusalem artichokes or corn.
- ✿ **Your garden area must be cleared of debris and disposed of by you, by November 29<sup>th</sup>** of all stakes, rocks, permanent ornaments, fixtures, etc., so that the College personnel can pre pare the area for winter. Do not leave your garden untidy for others to handle.
- ✿ Garden plots are not transferable and are assigned yearly.
